

**CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 20, 1997**

Mayor O'Harris called the Special City Council Meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. on March 20, 1997 in the Western District Courthouse. The subject of the meeting was the Sidewalk Ordinance, Ordinance #1698, in regards to a replacement of native limestone with the proper mix of concrete.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 a.m.
