**320 SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

**PRESENT:**

ALSO PRESENT: Some of the people stayed after the Transit Public Hearing and some left. It was hard to determine. Mr. Miner, Mr. Young and Clerk Lee were there. Also David McNeal, and Beau Satori.

Sally Riker, Promoter of the Blues Festival, asked the Council for three things:

1. To set up a tent between City Hall and the Auditorium. The tent is to sell beer and cold drinks and give the patrons a place to get out into the air and stretch their legs. Alderwoman Seratt made the motion to approve and Alderwoman Dickens seconded. All were in favor, 5/0/0.

2. To move the beer permit from Lake Leatherwood area to the Auditorium. Alderwoman Seratt made the motion Jeffrey seconded. All were in favor, 5/0/0.

3. To set up portable toilets outside. The motion and all were in favor, 5/0/0.

The motion was made and seconded to adjourn.  
The meeting was adjourned at 8:18 p.m.
