

ORDINANCE NO. 2222

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF MAYOR TO DO BUSINESS WITH THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS WHILE SERVING AS MAYOR

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has made a comprehensive study and review of the laws governing limitations of a Mayor being employed by or receiving funds from the City while serving as Mayor; and,

WHEREAS, the current Mayor has experience with providing goods and/or services to the City and its Commissions prior to his election; and,

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, the Mayor was elected by the electorate with full disclosure of his past relationship with the City and the City's Commissions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the current Mayor of the City of Eureka Springs is hereby specifically authorized to continue to do business of the same nature as his prior experience with the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas and its Commissions, including, but not limited to the Parks Commission, throughout the remainder of any current project until its completion.

Section 2. Repeal Clause: All Ordinances, Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Emergency Clause

Section 3. That due to need to complete timely current projects and to assure uninterrupted work thereon and for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City that those projects help assure; an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the Eureka Springs City Council and signing by the Eureka Springs Mayor.
