WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States of America has declared that all citizens of the United States have the same right to inherit, purchase, lease, sell, hold, and convey real property, and;

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States of America has declared that fair and open housing is to be the law of the land, and;


WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States of America has also declared that all citizens will have an equal opportunity for employment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

It is hereby declared to be the policy of the City of Eureka Springs to adhere to and comply with all provisions of the laws prohibiting discriminatory policies in relation to both the private and public use of housing, property ownership and employment opportunities. The City of Eureka Springs supports open housing and equal opportunity employment.
2. It is further herewith resolved that the City of Eureka Springs will promote fair housing and equal opportunity employment for all persons and utilize its efforts and energies to end any type of discrimination within the City of Eureka Springs.
