

RESOLUTION NO. 663

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2014 ADOPTED BUDGETS FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, FOR THE YEAR 2014; APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR EACH AND EVERY ITEM OF EXPENDITURE THERIN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES
